






CONTEXT

HEALTH


- absence of disease

"...extent to which an individual or group is able to realize aspirations and satisfy needs, and to change or cope with the environment. Health is a resource for everyday life, not the objective of living; it is a positive concept, emphasizing social and personal resources as well as physical capabilities."

DEFINITION: WHO

PUBLIC HEALTH

- concerns the "public"
- operates in an increasingly complex and rapidly changing landscape
- extend into other sectors that influence health opportunities and outcomes



QUESTIONS

- What predicts our ability to stay healthy and live a quality life?
- Where do health differences among social groups originate, if we trace them back to their deepest roots?
- What pathways lead from root causes to the stark differences in health status observed at the population level?
- Which intermediary factor plays an overwhelmingly influential role in our health?
